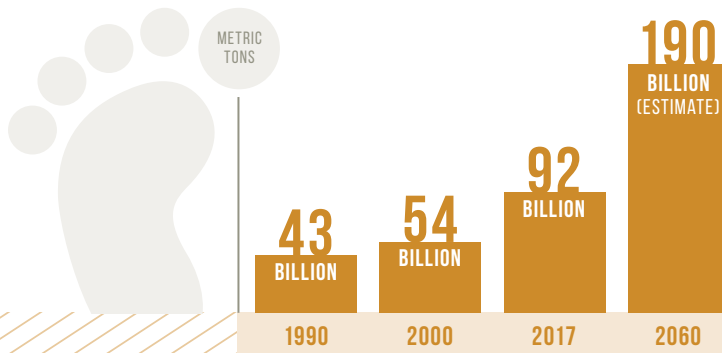




ENSURE SUSTAINABLE CONSUMPTION AND PRODUCTION PATTERNS

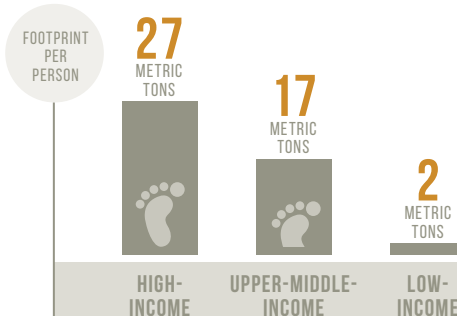


DEVELOPED COUNTRIES USE ONE FIFTH OF NATURAL RESOURCES
